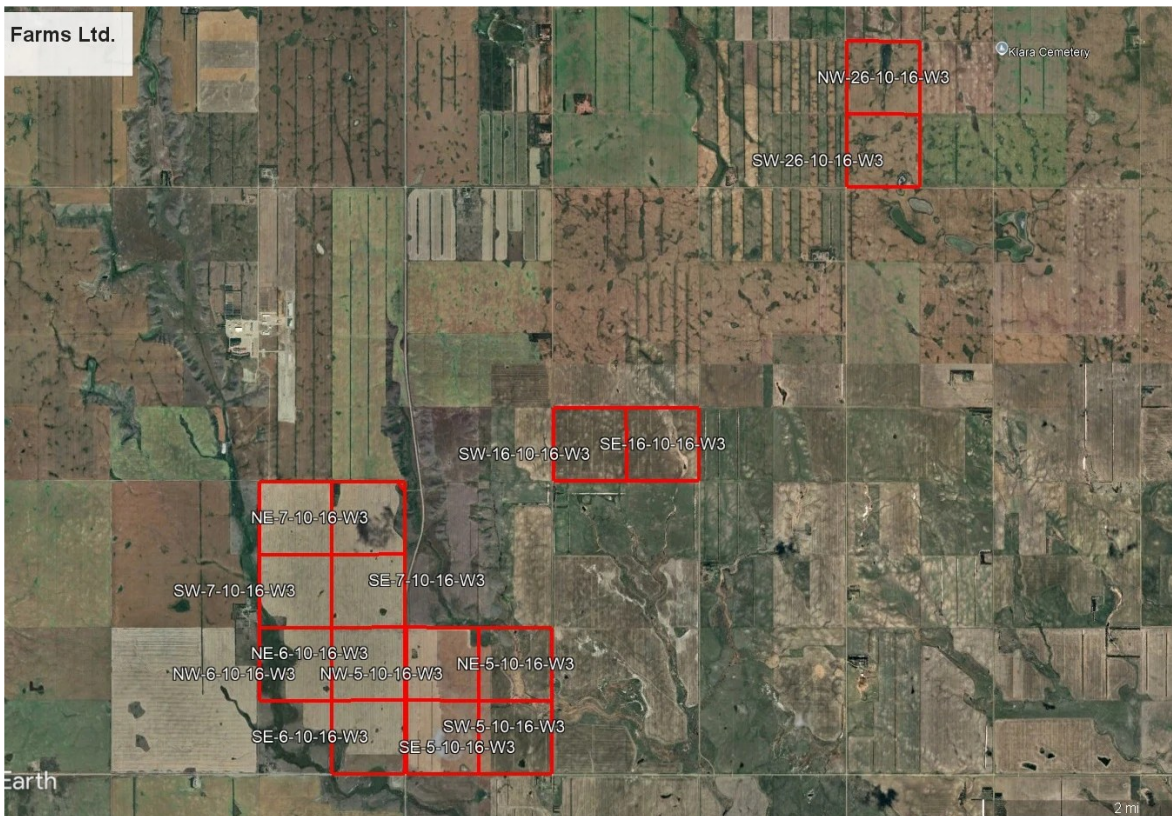

Description

Farmland

Located in the RM of Admiral No. 108 in southwest Saskatchewan, this package brings together 2,385.45 title acres of productive grain land, including 2,141 cultivated acres, in a tight geographic footprint that farms efficiently. The land is dominated by Ardill association soils with a clay loam texture — a soil profile well regarded across the southwest for its moisture-holding capacity and consistent performance in cereal, pulse, and oilseed rotations — with one Amulet clay loam quarter and one Echo clay quarter rounding out the package. SCIC crop insurance ratings across the parcels range from Class F through K, with the majority rated Class G and H, and all quarters sit within Risk Zone 3. The package carries a weighted average SAMA soil final rating of 53.54 and an average assessed fair value of \$294,647 per 160 acres, reflecting land that has been farmed and assessed as solid, dependable cropland. At nearly 2,400 acres in one municipality, this is a rare opportunity to add meaningful contiguous scale in the southwest — the kind of block that lets an operation grow without stretching its equipment or its people.

SAMA Information

This information is collected from Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency via field sheets on each individual parcel. It includes specific information such as: assessed value, uses of soil (cultivated, arable, pasture, wetlands, etc), number of acres for each use, soil profile information including association & texture, topography, stones, salinity and soil final rating.

Soil Final Rating

The final rating (FR) is the productivity rating for the acres adjusted for economic factors that affect the average cost of production for specified features. The economic factors include stones, topography, natural hazards, man-made hazards, tree cover and miles to market. The final rating units are index points per acre. Soils are given a rating from 100 (best) to 0 (worst). Soils with a final rating under 30 are marginal and rarely cropped.

Saskatchewan Crop Insurance Corporation (SCIC)

SCIC gives a class rating to every quarter section in Saskatchewan to reflect its productivity. Ratings range from Class A (best) to Class P (worst). There are 23 different risk zones in Saskatchewan. Please note a class B rating in risk zone 3 does not necessarily have the same productive capacity as a class B rating in risk zone 16.
